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## Statement

- Valley Vital Care provides products and services related to infusion and enteral therapies.
- The geographic service care for the pharmacy includes the following counties:

  - All counties in West Virginia: See map for reference
- Infusion therapies include:
  - Parenteral nutrition
  - Antibiotics and other antimicrobials
  - Fluid and electrolyte replacement
  - Pain management therapies
  - Chemotherapy
  - Biologic response modifiers and colony stimulating factors
  - Inotropic agents
  - Other parenteral medications deemed safe for use in the home
- Valley Vital Care provides the following services:
  - Compounding of medium and low risk preparations
  - Compounding of high risk preparations
  - Professional pharmacy services
  - Dietary consultation (may be provided by Vital Care Infusion Services, LLC)
  - Education by a nurse, pharmacist, or other trained and qualified staff member
  - After-hours on-call personnel
  - Delivery services
  - Disposal of equipment and supplies
- Valley Vital Care provides infusion nursing services as needed within the community (optional). Those nursing services would include:
  - Patient assessment
  - Venipuncture for lab specimens

- Insertion of vascular catheters
- Administration of medication via: intravenous, intramuscular, subcutaneous, and intraspinal routes
- Enteral medication and tube feeding administrations
- Patient education and counseling
- Valley Vital Care provides the following other medications or supplies:
  - Catheter flush medications such as heparin and saline;
  - Oral, topical, or other medications used as pre-medication or adjunct therapy to the infusion medication;
  - Disposable administration supplies;
  - Durable medical equipment such as pumps and poles;
  - Patient education materials.
- Valley Vital Care provides a full range of enteral nutrition therapy products and supplies. All supplies and equipment medically necessary for the administration of the prescribed therapy will be provided.
- The pharmacy provides care to patients in the following categories:

  - child
  - adult
  - geriatric
